Supplies:

- You must have your materials with you every day.
- Bring ALL items daily that are indicated on the Math Department Supply List.
- Bring your textbook, your notebook, and supplies.

Assignments:

- Must be finished BEFORE you come in to class.
- They must be done in PENCIL (not in any colors)
- They must be labeled with NAME, DATE, and ASSIGNMENT.
- Do your assignment on a new, clean piece of paper and be organized. I must be able to follow what you are doing so be neat.
- Keep assignments in the appropriate sections of your binder.
- Turn assignments in to Google Classroom ON TIME.
- <u>Late work</u> or work that is <u>done incorrectly</u> will receive a lowered grade. Work more than one day late will NOT be accepted.

Attendance & Missed Work:

- Be on time to class! If you are not in your seat when the bell BEGINS to ring you are considered tardy.
- Missing School? Check GOOGLE CLASSROOM for notes and homework.
- You will have one day to make up work for each day that you miss.
- Missed Tests and Quizzes must be made up after school as soon as possible when you return. Arrange a time with me when you return.
- If you are going to miss for a field trip or a vacation see me before you leave to get your work and check GOOGLE CLASSROOM for anything you may have missed.

Conduct in the Classroom:

Grades:

- Tests will be given at the end of each chapter and quizzes will be given once or twice per chapter.
- Many quizzes will be online in SchoolNet. Know your username and password.
- TESTS and QUIZZES will be reviewed in class but will not leave the classroom. I will keep them on file and you are welcome to come in and review them with me at any time.
- Assignments will be given daily and will be worth 1 to 10 points. These will be turned in ONLY on GOOGLE CLASSROOM and if they are turned in late NO credit will be given.
- Tests will comprise 80% of your overall grade. Homework will be 20% of your grade.
- Your final exam will count as 20% of your semester grade.
- Grades will NOT be rounded. You must WORK HARD for your grade.
